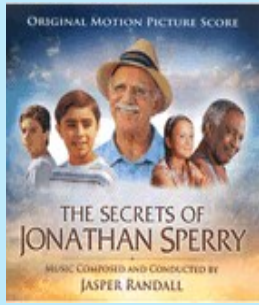

From the Pastor's Desk

It is time for the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering (LMCO) for International Missions. Not time to give, yet. We won't emphasize the offering until December. It is time to pray about how much you and your family will give.

100% of the LMCO goes to support almost 5,000 Southern Baptist missionaries serving all around the world. Our church gives every week to support those missionaries. When you give your tithes or offering to support our church budget, 10% goes to the Cooperative Program (CP). The CP supports the work of our state convention, the national convention, international missions, North American missions, and Southern Baptist seminaries. The CP is the ongoing lifeline of these ministries.

To supplement the work of the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention (IMB) we also receive a special offering during the Christmas season. The LMCO actually makes up over 1/2 of the IMB's annual budget. It is an offering that absolutely critical for our missionaries to do the work God has called us and them to do. That work is to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with all people groups.

Sit down with your family to discuss how much your family will give this year. Pray about it. Come up with creative ways to involve your children in saving and giving. Emmanuel has a long history of generosity when it comes to missions giving. Let's extend and grow that legacy.
